ZOWADA MOTION FOR RELIEF FROM ORDER

Being duly acknowledged by the Board that it had received the filed Motion for Relief from Order by Merlin H. and Lori Zowada, the having reviewed the arguments cited therein and the corresponding Special Appearance and Response to Zowadas' Motion for Relief from Order by the Mullinax Concrete and Service Company, Inc., the Board heard comments from attorneys Harlan Rasmussen, Tony Wendtland and Rob Connor on whether the Board still held jurisdiction in this matter. In addition, the Board acknowledged that it had received a copy of the Petition for Review, filed by the Zowadas in the Fourth Judicial District Court.

County and Prosecuting Attorney Matt Redle outlined the various cited rules and procedures used by the attorneys to argue whether the Board continues to hold jurisdiction. It was stated that Mr. Redle would prepare the Findings of Fact Conclusions of Law supporting the Board's belief that it does not hold jurisdiction to consider or rule on the filed motions.
