

MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF SHERIDAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

The Board met at 8:15 a.m., July 8, 2008, in special session at the Sheridan County Courthouse, Sheridan, Wyoming. Commissioner Steve Maier was present, with Commissioners Robert L. Rolston and Terry Cram absent. Commissioner Maier, citing that a quorum was not met for action by the Board, called the meeting to order and led everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance.

PROPERTY TAX DEFERRAL PROGRAM

Commissioner Maier outlined the process to adopt the amendment to the County's program. He said the original rules were effective on January 1, 1997 and one citizen took advantage of the Program. The Board has advised the Department of Revenue, the Attorney General and the County Clerk of its intention to amend the rules to bring them up to date with recent changes in legislation, to clarify language and definitions, and to prepare an application. Commissioner Maier said the Department of Revenue may deny or amend the County's proposed amendment before its adoption, however, the Department has not done so to date.

Commissioner Maier opened a duly advertised public hearing at 8:21 a.m. to receive public comment on the proposed rules which have been available on the County's website and by paper copy at the Courthouse. Hearing no comment, the hearing was closed at 8:22 a.m. Commissioner Maier said this matter will be continued to July 15, 2008 for further hearing and adoption.

ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 8:22 a.m.
