

MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF SHERIDAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

The Board met at 5:30 p.m., July 21, 2008, in special session at the Sheridan County Courthouse, Sheridan, Wyoming. Members present were Commissioners Robert L. Rolston, Steve Maier and Terry Cram. Chairman Rolston called the meeting to order and led everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Chairman Rolston advised that the special session was called for a duly advertised public hearing to receive comment on the proposed FY 2008-2009 Sheridan County budget. Renee Obermueller, Administrative Director, gave highlights of the projected revenue and expenditures from the budget message, included in the budget document.

COMMENTS BY COMMISSIONERS

The Board thanked Ms. Obermueller for her diligence in preparing the budget. Commissioner Cram said the planned job position and salary study will be very beneficial to the County. As the Commissioners are charged with maintaining the facility, Commissioner Maier said the upgrades to the Courthouse are expensive but are reasonable considering the new addition was built more than twenty years ago and should be adequate for years to come.

Chairman Rolston opened the public hearing at 5:41 p.m. to receive public comment. There being none, the hearing was closed at 5:42 p.m.
