

MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF SHERIDAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

The Board of County Commissioners met in special session at 9:03 a.m. on August 2, 2010, Sheridan County Courthouse. The special session was convened to consider certifying requested mill levies for the 2010-2011 fiscal year. Members present were Commissioners Terry Cram, Steve Maier, Mike Nickel, Tom Ringley and Robert L. Rolston.

Chairman Maier stated that in accordance with Wyoming Statute 39-13-102(g), the County Commissioners are charged to sit each year on or before the first Monday in August to certify mill levies for the collection of ad valorem taxes as requested by applicable governmental entities. These taxes shall be distributed as specified in the Board’s Order prepared by the Administrative Director in coordination with the County Assessor.

Comments by the County Commissioners addressed the significant drop in assessed valuation from \$793,523,685 in the 2009-2010 fiscal year to \$539,867,284, noting that the decreased valuation affects the budgets of the entities that rely on these funds. The County assesses 12 mills which is valued close to \$6.5 million for this period. The Commissioners stated that they had expected this drop and had planned for it. There were no public comments.

The Board authorized the Chairman to sign the Order of Approved Levies for fiscal year 2010-2011.
