

MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF SHERIDAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

The Board met at 8:15 a.m., August 28, 2008, in special session at the Sheridan County Courthouse, Sheridan, Wyoming. Members present were Commissioners Robert L. Rolston, Steve Maier and Terry Cram. Chairman Rolston called the meeting to order and led everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance.

AGENDA

Chairman Rolston said there are no changes to the agenda so it stands as published.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

There were no announcements.

BOARD OF EQUALIZATION

The Board recessed to convene as the Board of Equalization to consider the submittal of a Joint Motion to Certify to the State Board of Equalization a question by the Sheridan County Assessor and D Bar D Ranch, LLC. The question raised by D Bar D Ranch, LLC is that “We do not understand how the assessment was calculated. More information is needed to determine if the amount assessed was appropriate.” The remedy requested is for full disclosure of how the calculations were made and the information used is needed.

Finding agreement with the joint motion by the parties, the Board approved an Order Granting a Joint Motion to Certify to the State Board of Equalization for consideration of Sheridan County case number SC08-03, concerning county property No. 54850230000733. To certify the case to the State Board of Equalization, the Board approved the Board’s Order to authorize this transfer of jurisdiction. The Commissioners noted that the County Assessor is operating correctly by Wyoming statutes and this appeal does not reflect negatively on his office. The meeting of the Board of Equalization was adjourned at 8:23 a.m.

Reconvening the special session, the Board, with Deputy County Attorney Lynn Smith, determined that one matter could be removed from the executive session and considered in open meeting. The Board authorized the Chairman to execute an account assignment to Collection Professionals to attempt the collection of a bill due to the involuntary hospitalization of David Aaron Baker. The meeting was recessed at 8:30 a.m.

At 9:04 a.m., upon a motion duly made, the Board met in executive session, authorized by Wyoming Statute 16-4-405(iii), to discuss a matter with the Deputy County Attorney. Reconvening the special session at 9:15 a.m., Chairman Rolston advised that there would be no action taken at this time on the matter discussed.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:16 a.m.
