

MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF SHERIDAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

The Board met at 9:00 a.m., October 9, 2008, in special session at the Sheridan County Courthouse, Sheridan, Wyoming. Members present were Commissioners Robert L. Rolston, Steve Maier and Terry Cram. Chairman Rolston called the meeting to order and led everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Chairman Rolston advised that the Board was meeting to consider a bid award for the remodel of the second floor of the Courthouse. The remodel is the unintended consequence of the County electing two additional County Commissioners. He said Courthouse space is crowded now and space must be found for two more offices. Nothing has been done to the present structure since 1982 and heating, lighting and other infrastructure components need to be upgraded.

Upon a motion duly made and seconded, the Board awarded the contract bid to O'Dell Construction of Sheridan. Of the three bids received, O'Dell was the low bidder, in the amount of \$813,290, which was also under the engineering estimate.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:04 a.m.
