

MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF SHERIDAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

The Board met at 9:00 a.m., December 5, 2008, at the Sheridan County Fulmer Public Library, Sheridan, Wyoming. Members present were Commissioners Robert L. Rolston, Terry Cram and Steve Maier. Chairman Rolston called the meeting to order to commence a contested case hearing in the matter of a petition by Robert and Leona Adsit for the establishment of a private road. County Attorney Matt Redle acted as the hearing officer.

The parties, having previously stipulated that Robert and Leona Adsit (petitioners) do not have a legally enforceable access from their property to a public road, met to argue the merits of the proposed access and to consider the recommendation of the Viewers and Appraisers appointed to review the matter. The proposed access would cut across a corner of property owned by Douglas Adsit (respondent).

The Board heard testimony from the petitioner, the respondent, and Jerry Mark representing the Viewers and Appraisers. The Commissioners stated they would take the matter under advisement to determine the location of the access and assess damages, if any there may be. Findings of Fact Conclusions of Law will be issued when approved.
