

R E S O L U T I O N

LIMITED DETONATION OF FIREWORKS,

WHEREAS, pursuant to W.S. 35-10-208 and W.S. 35-9-301, the Board of County Commissioners may regulate the use of fireworks within the borders of the county and outside the corporate limits of any city or town in an effort to preserve and promote the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Sheridan County; and

WHEREAS, improper use of fireworks may be deemed harmful and a danger to property and life.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that fireworks may be detonated in Sheridan County during the period of June 27th through July 11th and during the months of December and January.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that detonation of fireworks during all other times may also be permitted to Sheridan County residents provided they first obtain written permission from the Fire Chief of the corresponding Fire District. Should the individual not reside within an established district, written permission must then be obtained from the County Fire Chief.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall supersede and rescind the resolution dated May 1, 1990.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall remain in effect until such time as it may be amended or rescinded by Board action.

R E S O L U T I O N

RESTRICTED STORAGE AND SALE OF FIREWORKS

WHEREAS, pursuant to W.S. 1977, Section 18-3-504(a)(v), the Board of County Commissioners may care for County property and manage the business and concerns of the county in all cases where no provision is made by law; and

WHEREAS, the location for the storage and sale of fireworks may be threatening to the common safety of the public; and


WHEREAS, pursuant to W.S. 1977, Section 35-9-111(a), the County Fire Warden, upon determining that a building or structure is especially liable to fire and endangers people, buildings or property in the vicinity, has the responsibility and authority to order the structure to be repaired, torn down or demolished, all materials removed, and all dangerous conditions remedied.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners does hereby instruct the County Fire Warden to prevent the storage and sale of fireworks within five hundred feet (500') of any facility selling or storing gasoline, diesel, propane or other highly combustible material.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall remain in effect until such time as it may be amended or rescinded.
