The Board of County Commissioners of Sheridan County, Wyoming met at 5:30 p.m., July 18, 2005, in Special Session. Members present were Chairman Lawrence A. Durante, Commissioner Terry Cram and Commissioner Ky Dixon. Chairman Durante called the meeting to order and then led everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Special Session was called as a public hearing pursuant to W.S. 16-4-111(a)(b) to receive the proposed FY 2005-2006 county budget and allow for public comment on the budget summary. Chairman Durante opened the public hearing at 5:35 p.m. and gave an overview of the items outlined in the Budget Message. Cathy Butler, Library Director, asked about the salary adjustments, which are formulated on 5% of the total county payroll except the elected and department heads, resulting in about \$130 per employee. Elected officials have the option of allocating such adjustments for their departments. Vicki Taylor inquired about the line item change approval procedure outlined in the Budget Message. The Board said that would be a procedure not a resolution at this time. The public hearing was closed at 5:42 p.m.

Commissioner Dixon thanked the County employees for a terrific job in holding to their budgets this past year. She said with the assessments made by our consulting firm on management practices and a comprehensive audit, we are now more confident of the county's budget status on a monthly basis.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:45 p.m.
