**ANNOUNCEMENTS:**

The resignation of Larry Roos from the Hospital Board of Trustees was announced. Persons interested in serving on this board should send a letter of interest to the Commission office.

**PUBLIC COMMENTS:**

Danny Brumm asked that the Commissioners sit in on Hospital Board meetings. He said there is no way to make comments to them, except in the early public comment period. Commissioner Dixon said that she is the liaison to the Hospital Board as it is county property and does attend the Board's meetings. She said the Hospital Board is a policy making body and is independent to make budget and operating decisions.

Jack Moriarty, resident of Taylor Road, commented on the method used to gravel Lower Prairie Dog Road. The Board asked Public Works Director Bruce Yates to give them a report on the short and long-range plans to ensure road quality at the next Board meeting.

**JAIL PROJECT:**

The Board approved change order #30 to the Ormond Builders contract, in the amount of \$1,803, for additional work to install conduit and a data line to serve the fingerprint machine and two pieces of stainless steel to cover exposed block at doorway opening.

Responding to a newspaper article by the out-going Detention Officer last month, Commissioner Durante asked Special Projects Coordinator Gary Meyer whether the Sheriff had reviewed and approved the new jail addition-remodel, and if the Sheriff had requested any change orders to the jail project. Mr. Meyer said he reviewed all plans with everyone involved, including the Sheriff, and that individual meetings were held to discuss the operation of the facility with the consultants and the Sheriff. Mr. Meyer said certain change orders have been due to requests by the Sheriff. Mr. Meyer said they are on schedule for a September completion.

**PARTIAL FIRE RESTRICTIONS:**

Sheridan County Fire Warden Bill Biastoch said we are at extreme drought again, with two inches behind in rain. Upon the advice of the Sheridan County Fire Warden and Fire Chiefs, the Board approved Resolution 06-07-014, declaring partial fire restrictions in Sheridan County to be in effect immediately. The Commissioners said if conditions warrant, they would entertain lifting restrictions in the fall separately in areas west and east of the interstate highway for instance. Mr. Biastoch will advise the Commissioners on logical boundaries to split the county in areas to accomplish this.

**RESOLUTION 06-07-014**

**PARTIAL FIRE RESTRICTIONS IN SHERIDAN COUNTY**

WHEREAS, the danger from forest and range fires on lands within Sheridan County has an excessive amount of inflammable material available; and

WHEREAS, the State Forester is urging counties to impose fire restrictions due to hot and dry conditions across the state which have produced several large fires of more than 100 acres; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has unanimously recognized the necessity for fire control measures in Sheridan County; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Wyoming Statute 35-9-301, the Board of County Commissioners are hereby duly authorized to close any or all state, county and private lands that lie outside incorporated areas within their respective county, to open fires or other uses which constitute a serious threat to forest or range fire.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners hereby declares that fires and open flames shall be allowed in improved areas only within the following parameters:

1. Trash or refuse fires are permitted, between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m., in a container provided with a spark arrester and located in the center of a cleared area, ten (10) feet in radius.
2. Campfires are permitted only if contained within an established fire ring at an established campground.
3. Charcoal fires are permitted contained within enclosed grills.

4. Use of acetylene cutting torches or electric welders are permitted in cleared areas, ten (10) feet in radius.
5. Propane or open-fire branding activities are permitted in cleared areas, ten (10) feet in radius.
6. No open fires or open flame shall be permitted in unimproved areas.
7. Discharge of all fireworks is strictly prohibited, unless permitted by the process and procedure established by the Board of County Commissioners. The term "fireworks" shall not be construed as being synonymous with "fireworks" under W.S. 35-10-201. As used herein, the term shall be considered as meaning any pyrotechnic or explosive device regardless of the quantity of explosive contained therein.
8. Planned burning may be permitted to Sheridan County residents provided that they first obtain permission from the District Fire Chief of the corresponding Fire District. Should the resident not reside within an established District, permission must then be obtained from the Fire Chief of the City of Sheridan, who acts as agent of the Sheridan County Fire Warden and District Fire Chiefs.
9. There is no restriction on smoking.
10. There are no restrictions on cabin chimneys or flues. It is, however, advisable to install spark arresters or screens.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the area of said fire control measures shall include all state, county and private properties within Sheridan County except lands located within incorporated areas; municipal governments having authority to declare fire restrictions locally; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, pursuant to W.S. 35-9-304, any person violating this Resolution on state, county and private properties that fall under the jurisdiction of Sheridan County shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine not to exceed one-hundred dollars (\$100) or imprisonment in the County jail not to exceed thirty (30) days, or both such fine and imprisonment; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Resolution 06-07-014 supersedes all previous resolutions; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Resolution 06-07-014 becomes July 6, 2006, and shall remain in effect until such time as it may be amended or rescinded by Board action.

**FIRE AND AMBULANCE SERVICE AGREEMENT:**

Commissioner Durante acknowledged receiving Mayor Kinskey's letter notifying of the expiration of the agreement on December 31, 2006. Since that time, the Mayor has advised that the County must pay \$850,000 to \$1 million to continue to provide service to residents in the unincorporated area of the county not in a fire district. Commissioner Durante said the county does not have this amount of money. He said that the county has requested from the city the annual reports to review costs, which have not been received in adequate detail. Commissioner Dixon said the Board was aware that the agreement renewal would need to be negotiated, but expected that it would be a reasonable increase as provided for in the agreement. She said fire and ambulance services are separate issues and could be individually contracted if necessary.

The option to create a new district for this area, if presented and passed by the voters, would cost taxpayers more money until the new district was organized, equipped and receiving funds in 2008. Mr. Biastoch said he has been gathering information from the state to determine the basis of the request to increase the county's contribution.. Commissioner Dixon said the County pays for this expense from the One-Cent Optional Sales Tax which would be in jeopardy if not renewed. The current agreement calls for the County to pay for one engine and 3-4 persons to respond to an emergency. She suggested the county negotiate an interim agreement until the options could be considered and acted upon. Commissioner Durante said that the Mayor expressed no interest in compromising on the suggested rate. He commented that the State Board of Equalization last year denied the Commissioners' request to levy landowners within that "donut" area to the city of Sheridan not included in a fire district. Such taxes could only be assessed if a fire district was formed.

#### SHERIDAN COUNTY AIRPORT:

The Board accepted the grant offer from the Federal Aviation Administration to fund the design portion of the general aviation apron and taxiway rehabilitation, in the amount of \$96,636, and authorized the Chairman to execute the documents. Manager John Stopka said the State Aeronautics Division would also contribute once this grant amount was accepted.

At the request of the FAA, the Board approved the transfer of \$331,125 of Sheridan's 2006 entitlements to the Gillette-Campbell County Airport and authorized the Chairman to sign the Agreement documents, pending receipt of a reciprocation letter from its Airport Board. The amount would be returned to Sheridan County next year.

Only one bid was received for repair of the runway 14 safety area slide problem. The Board, with the concurrence of the FAA and WYDOT Aeronautics Division, rejected the bid received from Western Municipal for the slide repair as being excessively above the engineering estimate. The slide area presents no immediate danger but must be repaired to FAA standards. The project will be rebid this winter.

#### SHERIDAN COUNTY HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION:

The Board approved the grant agreement with the Wyoming State Historic Preservation Office for the term July 25, 2006 through September 30, 2007, in an amount not to exceed \$1,418. The grant will allow Commission Chairman Billie Little to attend the National Alliance of Preservation Commissions 2006 Forum and report to the state office.

#### CLERK OF DISTRICT COURT:

The Board approved the Memorandum of Agreement between the Clerk of District Court and the Wyoming Supreme Court regarding the use of court data; the agreement to remain in full force until terminated as provided.

#### TOWN OF DAYTON:

The Board approved providing a letter of support to the Town of Dayton to be included with its grant request to the Wyoming Water Development Commission for funding a feasibility study to use its old water main to provide untreated water for lawn watering purposes.

#### COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS:

Facility Director Sharon Nadeau advised that the needs determination required to consider moving the fairgrounds was expected to be complete August 1, and that additional time

is required to close out the grant award. The Board authorized the Chairman to submit a request to the Wyoming Business Council to extend to December 31, 2006 the Planning Only grant term. Business Manager Renee Obermueller said the fairgrounds received \$298,800 from the general fixed costs budget last year. This year \$305,000 is proposed.

COMMUNICATION SITE LEASE:

This item was placed on the Table pending discussion with the County Attorney.

OFFICIAL BOND AND OATH:

The Board ordered filed a bond for Scott B. Barten, Treasurer of the Sheridan County Fair Association, for the term ending January 16, 2011, in the amount of \$10,000.

ADJOURNMENT:

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 10:20 a.m.
