The Board of County Commissioners of Sheridan County, Wyoming met at the time and place above-mentioned in Special Session. Members present were Chairman Terry Cram, Commissioner Lawrence A. Durante and Commissioner Ky Dixon. Chairman Cram called the meeting to order and then led everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Chairman Cram advised that the meeting was called to consider a petition by Merlin H. and Lori Zowada, operating a metal recycling business, for the establishment of a private road, leading from their property across property belonging to Mullinax Concrete. He said the Board would receive oral and written testimony pertaining to the petition, noting that temporary access has been granted to the Zowadas until the establishment process is completed.

Harlan Rasmussen, representing the Zowadas, and Tony Wendtland, representing Nathan and Bob Mullinax presented arguments supporting each position as to whether the Zowadas have a legally enforceable access to the property. Deputy County Attorney Charmaine Reed acted as hearing officer for the contested case.

Upon completion of the testimony, the Commissioners said they would take the matter under advisement and render a decision within the prescribed 30 days by Wyoming Statute.

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 11:15 a.m.
