AGENDA:

The Board approved the Agenda as published.

ANNOUNCEMENTS:

Commissioner Dixon said that the Center for a Vital Community and SAWS sponsored an informational meeting at Sheridan College on October 4. University of Wyoming Professor Don McLeod spoke on the impacts of growth, along with comments by local officials on other aspects of water supply.

Commissioner Dixon said the draft Subdivision Resolution has been distributed to Board members, the Planning and Zoning Commission, and various engineering and surveying professionals for review. The Board will hold a public hearing on November 21. The public may go to www.sheridancounty.com or pick up a copy in the Public Works or Board offices. The amended Resolution will improve language clarity and address areas that have often caused difficulty to landowners, developers or County staff.

Chairman Cram said the proposed Sheridan Area Rural Fire Protection District is on the November ballot. If a positive vote by eligible electors, the Board shall appoint the initial, three member Board of Directors for the new district. Persons who are interested in serving in this capacity should direct a letter of interest to the Commission office as soon as possible. He said the district map and information notes have been posted on the County website. Two informational meetings will be held; October 10 at the Holiday Convention Center and October 25 at Whitney 136, Sheridan College. Chairman Cram said the impact on property taxes is \$28.50 per \$100,000 of market valuation.

Chairman Cram said the Chamber of Commerce is taking the lead on distributing information on the One-Cent Optional Tax measure. Business Manager Renee Obermueller said the information brochure is at the printers and should be distributed to households shortly.

PUBLIC COMMENTS:

There were no comments from the public.

PARI-MUTUEL WAGERING

Chairman Cram acknowledged that the Board had received a request from Wyoming Entertainment, LLC. to operate off-track wagering in Sheridan County. He said that an election was held here in 1968 authorizing such wagering to take place in the County. He said the Board would take no action regarding this request until a representative of Wyoming Entertainment could be here to answer questions.

HOMELAND SECURITY GRANTS

Emergency Management Coordinator Dave Coleman reported that the main Homeland Security grant funds equipment purchases for first responders. The amount is less than half of last year's allocation. He said training is performed on equipment purchased.

Mr. Coleman said that Dayton has received its emergency siren purchased under last year's grant. It will be installed on top of the fire hall. He noted that the emergency command trailer is stored at the Big Horn fire hall. This vehicle would be used in various emergency situations if standard communications should be impaired. He said a one-ton vehicle needs to be purchased to pull the trailer.

The Board authorized the Chairman to execute the State Homeland Security Grant Allocation, in the amount of \$134,041.67, for the term ending March 31, 2008, Project ID #06-ODP-SHE-SC-HSG6.

The Board authorized the Chairman to execute the Homeland Security Citizen Corps Program grant allocation, in the amount of \$5,955.92, for the term ending March 31, 2008, Project ID #06-ODP-SHE-CC-HCC6.

The Board authorized the Chairman to execute the Homeland Security Sheriff's Department, in the amount of \$31,680, for the term July 1, 2006 through March 31, 2008, Project ID #06-ODP-SHE-LS-HLE6.

COMMUNITY HEALTH

Nurse Manager Judy Stallman said the Maternal Family Health program is the County's most effective program allowing home visitation for low income, first time parents, and especially serving children with special health needs. The office performed 495 visits last year. The Board authorized the Chairman to execute the contract between the Department of Health, Community and Rural Health Division's Maternal Family Health Section and Sheridan County to provide assistance to Community Health to plan, deliver and evaluate coordinated maternal and child health services, in an amount not to exceed \$51,337.50, for the term October 1, 2006 through September 30, 2007.

The Board also authorized the Chairman to execute the contract between the Wyoming Department of Health, Community and Rural Health, Public Health Nursing, and Sheridan County for public health emergency preparedness, in an amount not to exceed \$8,270, for the term August 1, 2006 through December 31, 2006. These funds are allocated for County preparations for a pandemic flu event. Ms. Stallman and Dee Neavill, Sheridan Memorial Hospital, outlined how patients would be handled and the effect on the community's workforce.

Both these contracts were approved contingent upon receiving new contracts for signature, with language corrected to indicate that Sheridan County does not waive governmental immunity and is covered by the indemnification clause.

WYCAN

The Board authorized the Chairman to execute the grant award contract between the Department of Family Services and Sheridan County on behalf of Wyoming Children's Access Network for it to provide assistance to needy families with children through the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Community Partnership Initiative, in an amount not to exceed \$50,000, for the term October 1, 2006 through September 30, 2007.

Q-06-006; STATE LANDS/WYDOT QUARRY PUBLIC HEARING

Public Works Director Bruce Yates reported that this request was to provide gravel for a WYDOT project. The quarry is located above Steamboat Point off Highway 14. He said the property description as stated in the staff report should be correctly described as E1/2SW1/4SW1/4SW1/4;W1/2NWSWSW;SE1/4NW1/4SW1/4SW1/4. The Board approved the State Lands/WYDOT Quarry with the following conditions:

1. Dust control on haul roads, stockpiles and work areas, as needed, in accordance with requirements of the County Engineer and Section 23 of the Zoning Resolution.
2. Permit shall be effective for 4 years, beginning from the date of approval by the Board of County Commissioners.

3. Operations shall be limited to 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Saturday, with no Sunday operations.
4. Applicant shall provide to the County Engineer any permits or renewed permits as required by the State throughout the life of the project, as well as changes that may take place to the operation of the quarry due to changes in regulations or permissions from the State of Wyoming.
5. Signage shall be limited to directional signage at the entrance of the site and DEQ required signage.

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 10:25 a.m.
