#### AGENDA:

The Board approved the Agenda as published.

#### ANNOUNCEMENTS:

Chairman Cram advised that there are vacancies on the Sheridan County Historic Preservation Commission.

#### PUBLIC COMMENTS:

Randy Kouf, Northeast Safety, outlined its services to train employees to OSHA safety standards. He said he has found non-compliance in local companies and he spoke to the need for proper training. The Commissioners asked for more information regarding available training.

#### PROJECT YOUTH

At the request of Todd Richins, Project Youth, the Board authorized the Chairman to sign a letter on the Board's behalf, supporting a Strategic Prevention Framework State Incentive Grant application for Project Youth to fund a program to reduce the misuse of alcohol. Mr. Richins said Project Youth is a program of the Sheridan Community Education Foundation, and is the lead local agency for this grant which will be implemented with the support of the school district and other community organizations.

#### SHERIDAN COUNTY AIRPORT

The Board authorized the Chairman to sign a Certificate of Completion of Construction for Phase 1A work at the Airport Business Park which is required to close a grant contract with the Wyoming Business Council.

The Board approved a Fixed Base Operator Lease Agreement with Bighorn Airways, Inc. for a term of 20 years ending October 31, 2026, with a 10-year extension option, at a monthly rate of \$1,800 as may be adjusted, subject to all terms of the agreement.

The Board approved an Amendment to the Lease Agreement of March 7, 1973 as amended, with Bighorn Airways, Inc., which revises the section concerning fuel flowage fees so that this agreement is consistent with the fees specified in the Fixed Base Operator Lease Agreement with Bighorn Airways, Inc. noted above.

SHERIDAN HEIGHTS RANCH QUARRY; Q-06-008

GRIFFITH QUARRY; Q-06-009

RICE QUARRY; Q-06-010

Chairman Cram opened the public hearing of the Sheridan Heights Ranch Quarry at 9:47 a.m. As the above three quarry applications share property boundaries and will operate one pit together, the Commissioners elected to combine these applications for hearing. Larry Ligoeki of Mullinax Concrete responded to questions as operator of the pit. No one else spoke to this issue. The public hearing was closed at 9:55 a.m. As recommended by the Planning and Zoning Commission and Planning staff, the Board approved the Sheridan Heights Ranch Quarry, the Griffith Quarry and the Rice Quarry, each with the following conditions:

1. Permit holder shall apply dust control on haul roads, stockpiles and work areas, as needed, and as required in accordance with the requirements of the County Engineer and Section 23 of the Zoning Resolution.
2. Permit shall be effective for 10 years, beginning November 7, 2006.
3. Permit holder shall provide to the County Engineer any permits or renewed permits as required by the State throughout the life of the project, as well as changes that may take place to the operation of the quarry due to changes in regulations or permissions from the State of Wyoming.
4. The permit holder and operator will cooperate with the County Engineer and Sheridan County Road and Bridge on any matters dealing with the integrity and safety of county roads that are used for hauling.
5. No crushing of materials shall be permitted on site.
6. Operations shall be limited weekdays to 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., with Saturday operations from 7:30 a.m. to Noon. No Sunday operations shall be permitted.
7. Haul trucks shall not utilize CR 80, Mydland Road.

#### WEERTS REZONE; R-06-004

Chairman Cram opened the public hearing at 10:07 a.m. Land Development Coordinator Robin DeBolt advised that Keith and Kim Weerts were requesting 24.80 acres be rezoned from Agricultural to Rural Residential. This area has both Urban Residential and Rural Residential zoning. Rural Residential was requested to retain open space. Ron Lytton, a neighbor, said he had no objection. The public hearing was closed at 10:16 p.m. The Board approved the rezone of this property to Rural Residential.

#### WYDOT DUST MITIGATION GRANT

Special Projects Coordinator Gary Meyer said this is the second round of funding offered through WYDOT's congestion mitigation-air quality (CMAQ) grant program. The selected County projects are roads with scoria surfaces. The Board approved Resolution 06-11-029, authorizing the Chairman to submit an application to the Wyoming Department of Transportation for \$401,920 in CMAQ funding to apply dust palliative on portions of Murphy Gulch, Wolf Creek and Beaver Creek roads, and to apply 6-inches of gravel on Murphy Gulch Road.

#### RIGHT-OF-WAY LICENSEES

Gene Kilpatrick, Three Left-Handers, asked the Board to reconsider the condition attached to License 05-17 requiring that a two-inch asphalt overlay be applied on Westview Drive. Sewer improvements to Ospry Hills Subdivision were installed in the right-of-way parallel to the road, not down the middle of the road as originally planned. Repair of these disturbed portions have been made. Jeff Dahlen, Intermountain Construction and Materials, said

he has inspected the road and he advised the Board on the standards and costs of asphalt and chip sealed roads. County Engineer Bruce Yates said he agreed with Mr. Dahlen's comments but was concerned about the repair at the manhole cover locations. He said the road grade needed to be correct otherwise it would not hold. After much discussion, the Board tabled consideration to allow engineering staff to confer with Mr. Kilpatrick on the appropriate repair of the road.

The Board approved Right-of-way Licenses 06-42 to MDU to make two bored electric and gas crossings of Swaim Road; 06-43 to Hettinger Welding, LLC (Cedar Resources Corp.) to make a bored gas crossing of South Prong Road; 06-44 to Qwest to make a bored 100-pair copper cable and partially plowed crossing of East Ridge Road; and 06-45 to Qwest to make a bored 50-pair copper cable crossing of Swaim Road. All approved licenses were conditioned on: (1) The Licensee providing a traffic control plan to the County Engineer for approval prior to construction for any work in the County right-of-way, and (2) The Licensee contacting the County Engineer 24-hours prior to construction to request inspections.

#### COUNTY HEALTH OFFICER

The Board authorized the Chairman to execute a contract between the Wyoming Department of Health and Michael Strahan as Sheridan County Health Officer to serve as the Bioterrorism Representative. The contract is for the period August 31, 2006 through August 30, 2007, in an amount not to exceed \$12,000.

#### PREDATOR MANAGEMENT DISTRICT

The Board reappointed Alan Osterland to the Sheridan County Predator Management District for a three-year term, expiring January 1, 2010.

#### HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION

The Board reappointed Bill Raymond to the Sheridan County Historic Preservation Commission for a three-year term expiring November 18, 2009.

#### BOND

The Board approved an Official Bond and Oath for Mavis Biastoch to act as Treasurer of the Sheridan County Fire Board for a term ending May 7, 2007, in the coverage amount of \$6,000.

#### WOODLAND HILLS I&SD

Chairman Cram acknowledged a petition received from Daniel and Virginia Adsit requesting exclusion from the Woodland Hills Improvement and Service District. Chairman Cram said the petition was reviewed by the County Attorney's Office and a response was given to Mr. and Mrs. Adsit. Upon advice of counsel, the Board took no action on the petition because it did not comply with the statutory requirements.

#### ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 11:13 a.m.
