**AGENDA:**

The Board approved the Agenda as published.

#### ANNOUNCEMENTS:

Chairman Cram advised that the County has received approval from the state to use the Bucking Horse and Rider trademark. This will be indicated on County communication repeater housings.

Chairman Cram announced that Mark Reid, Laramie County Planner, has accepted an offer to become the Sheridan County Planner. He will be here January 16, 2007.

#### PUBLIC COMMENTS:

Robert Connor, representing Big Horn Beverage, registered his objections into the record regarding the Zowada petition to establish a private road. He noted that he was barred by the viewers from being present during the tour of the subject properties and that the meeting following was not on site but in the County Courthouse. He said he also was not a party to the agreement between the principals' attorneys setting the date that the report would be due to the Board at a time later than that specified by statute since only three days would have been given to the viewers to prepare the report. He said he had joined in the objections stated by the Santa Fe Railroad Company and that he was present today to hear the viewers' report. Upon advice that the viewers had questions of the Deputy County Attorney who has been ill, the Board said the report would be received at the next meeting.

#### SUBDIVISION RESOLUTION

Chairman Cram opened the public hearing at 9:26 a.m., continuing the hearing from November 21. Commissioner Dixon noted that several small changes to the posted draft have been suggested which were outlined. Public Works Director Bruce Yates spoke regarding survey monuments and suggested language to be included under Section 3.12 of the document. No one else spoke to this issue and the hearing was closed at 9:31 a.m. The Board approved including the suggested changes into the draft document. It was directed that the changes be listed on the website along with the current draft. With that, the Board adopted the amended document as the Sheridan County Subdivision Resolution.

#### ESTABLISHMENT OF A PRIVATE ROAD

Upon advice of counsel, the Board voted to add "Acknowledgement of the Zowada Viewers' Report" to the agenda. For the record, it was noted that Viewer Roy Garber had asked questions of Deputy County Attorney Charmaine Reed. He received a response from Ms. Reed and Matt Redle on the questions, generally being the nature of whether the private road was deeded property or an easement; the viewers power to provide alternative options for location of the road to the Board; and clarification of their duties as viewers. Due to the delay being beyond the Board's control, an extension of time was approved to receive the report which will be at the next regular meeting on December 19, 2006.

#### HOMELAND SECURITY CONTRACT

Steve Small, Chairman of the Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC), advised that this contract would fund the operating budget of the Committee for the next fiscal year. The Board authorized the Chairman to accept and sign the grant award agreement with the Wyoming Office of Homeland Security on behalf of the LEPC, in the amount of \$1,485.79, to fund the development, improvement and implementation of hazardous materials emergency plans, for the term October 1, 2006 through September 30, 2007.

## FIRE DISTRICT

Chairman Cram said that the Board had received ten applications for the newly formed Sheridan Area Rural Fire Protection District board of directors. It was with satisfaction that the Board appointed David K. Masters, Randy Rowland and Chuck Simon as the initial directors of the District who will serve until District Fire Board elections are called in November 2008.

## JAIL PROJECT

Special Projects Coordinator Gary Meyer advised that change order #31 would close out the Ormond Builders contract. The final payment to Ormond would be in the amount of \$9,001.10. The Board approved change order #31, in the credit amount of \$6,840, which is due to the deletion of a sub-day room in the men's maximum security area. Mr. Meyer said he would have the final change order to the Plan One Architects contract ready for the next Board meeting.

## COLLEGE AVENUE

Mr. Meyer advised that a portion of Prairie Dog Road was not improved where it was located back in the 1920s. This portion is now within a subdivision inside the city limits and known as College Avenue. The Board approved the execution of a quitclaim deed to the City of Sheridan, transferring all interest held by Sheridan County, if any, in College Avenue.

## HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION

The Board appointed Wayne Baumann as a member of the Commission for a three-year Term, expiring December 31, 2009.

## LITTLE BIGHORN RIVER

Dave Bragonier, Wyoming Wildlife Federation, was present to ask for the Board's support in an effort to seek Wild and Scenic River designation for portions of the Little Bighorn River and Dry Fork drainage. He said that the Powder River Basin Resource Council, Sheridan County Sportsmen Association, Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation, Wyoming Conservation Voters, the Nature Conservancy, and the Sheridan Area Resource Council have joined in this effort. He noted that Bill Bass, Bighorn National Forest, has confirmed that the designation would fit with the revised Forest Plan. Matt Jones of Senator Thomas' office said that public comment could be directed to his office. Jill Morrison of the Powder River Resource Council said this area is important for habitat and recreation. The Board voted to offer a letter of support in this effort.

## ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 10:24 a.m.
