PRIVATE ROAD ESTABLISHMENT

The Board approved an Order Setting Time for Viewing and Appraising in the matter of the petition of Merlin H. Zowada and Lori Zowada to establish a private road. The appointed viewers shall meet on the requested road location at 9:00 a.m. on July 18, 2007 to view the properties.

BURTON SUBDIVISION; S-07-005M

This subdivision was approved by the Board on June 5, 2007, however, Bev Burton has requested an adjustment in the property line between lots 1 and 2. As the original plat had not yet been recorded, and the requested adjustment would not increase density, the Board approved the revised plat of the Burton Subdivision with a variance allowing lots 2 and 3 to be accessed with a 50-foot easement instead of the required 60-foot easement off Cotton Grove Avenue. Applied conditions are that building permits with inspections shall be required; and an advanced septic treatment system shall be installed on lot 1 to provide proper separation of ground water.

BLUE GRASS ACRES MINOR SUBDIVISION; S-07-006M

This is a request by Cheryl Barker to divide tract 1 of the Blue Grass Meadows Minor Subdivision, accessed off Owl Creek Road, to create three lots (tracts A-B-C) from 117.9 acres zoned Rural Residential. The Board approved the subdivision, allowing a change in name at the request of the applicant, to Blue Grass Meadows Minor #2 Subdivision, with a variance authorizing a 50-foot access easement instead of the required 60-foot easement for Owl Creek Road. Other conditions applied are that (1) any further subdividing of Tract C within the floodplain zone shall require an additional flood elevation study; (2) building permits with inspections shall be required; and (3) further subdividing of this subdivision shall require fire hydrants throughout the entire subdivision pursuant to fire district requirements.

COUNTY EMPLOYEE PAYROLL

The Board rescinded Resolution 07-06-011, authorizing mandatory direct deposit of employee compensation. The Commissioners said they would encourage county employees to take advantage of this direct deposit program, but that participation would not be mandatory.

FOREST RESERVE FUNDS

Administrative Director Renee Obermueller advised that each year Sheridan County receives approximately \$110,000 in funding through the Governor's office from the U.S. Forest Service under the Secure Rural Schools and Community Self Determination Act. The Board gave notice of its intention to elect to receive the full-payment option and to allocate 20% of such funds, the maximum allowed, to Title III search and rescue efforts. The Board proposed to budget 15% to Sheridan County Search and Rescue and 5% to the Civil Air Patrol. The public is invited to submit written comments on the Board's intention through August 16, 2007.

COUNTY BUDGET

The Board acknowledged receiving the summary of the County's proposed FY 2007-2008 budget as prepared by the Administrative Director. Pursuant to W.S. 16-4-109(a), the summary shall be published July 9, one week prior to the public hearing which is scheduled for 5:30 p.m., July 16, 2007.

FIRE RESTRICTIONS

Sheridan County Fire Warden Bill Biastoch advised that the wet spring has produced tall grass which is beginning to dry, increasing fire danger. He said the rural fire protection districts will not issue special burning permits during the 2007 burn ban period. The Board approved Resolution 07-07-013, authorizing partial fire restrictions effective July 12, 2007.

RESOLUTION 07-07-013

PARTIAL FIRE RESTRICTIONS IN SHERIDAN COUNTY

WHEREAS, the danger from forest and range fires on lands within Sheridan County has an excessive amount of inflammable material available; and

WHEREAS, the State Forester is urging counties to impose fire restrictions due to hot and dry conditions across the state which have produced several large fires of more than 100 acres; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has unanimously recognized the necessity for fire control measures in Sheridan County; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Wyoming Statute 35-9-301, the Board of County Commissioners are hereby duly authorized to close any or all state, county and private lands that lie outside incorporated areas within their respective county, to open fires or other uses which constitute a serious threat to forest or range fire.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners hereby declares that fires and open flames shall be allowed in improved areas only within the following parameters:

1. Trash or refuse fires are permitted, between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m., in a container provided with a spark arrester and located in the center of a cleared area, ten (10) feet in radius.
2. Campfires are permitted only if contained within an established fire ring at an established campground.
3. Charcoal fires are permitted contained within enclosed grills.
4. Use of acetylene cutting torches or electric welders are permitted in cleared areas, ten (10) feet in radius.
5. Propane or open-fire branding activities are permitted in cleared areas, ten (10) feet in radius.
6. No open fires or open flame shall be permitted in unimproved areas.
7. Discharge of all fireworks is strictly prohibited, unless permitted by the process and procedure established by the Board of County Commissioners. The term "fireworks" shall not be construed as being synonymous with "fireworks" under W.S. 35-10-201. As used herein, the term shall be considered as meaning any pyrotechnic or explosive device regardless of the quantity of explosive contained therein.
8. There is no restriction on smoking.
9. There are no restrictions on cabin chimneys or flues. It is, however, advisable to install spark arresters or screens.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the area of said fire control measures shall include all state, county and private properties within Sheridan County except lands located within incorporated areas; municipal governments having authority to declare fire restrictions locally; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, pursuant to W.S. 35-9-304, any person violating this Resolution on state, county and private properties that fall under the jurisdiction of Sheridan County shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine not to exceed one-hundred dollars (\$100) or imprisonment in the County jail not to exceed thirty (30) days, or both such fine and imprisonment; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Resolution 07-07-013 supersedes all previous resolutions; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Resolution 07-07-013 becomes **effective July 12, 2007** and shall remain in effect until such time as it may be amended or rescinded by Board action.
