

**Public Works Director *Rod Liesinger***

Rod manages the Public Works Department in addition to being a County Engineer and SAWSJPB Administrator.

**Building Inspector *Steve Bond***

Steve is responsible for building codes, permits and inspections. Assists with flood plain determinations, small wastewater and zoning issues.

**County Engineer *Ken Muller***

Ken is responsible for planning, designing and drafting of re-construction, grading, surfacing, culvert, bridge and other projects and preparing contract documents. He supervises survey activities for road and bridge and other projects. He also supervises the construction, inspections, and administration of bridge and culvert, gravel surfacing, asphalt and concrete paving, road grading, chloride applications, and other projects.

**County Planner *Mark Reid***

Mark is responsible for administration of the Zoning Resolution and creating and updating long-range plans for Sheridan County to include a current Comprehensive Plan. Elements of the Comprehensive Plan include Land Use, Transportation, County Utilities, Sensitive Areas, Natural & Manmade Hazards, and Open Space. He is also responsible for administering the Sheridan County Subdivision Resolution, Rezoning permits, Quarry permits, Variance permits, Conditional Use permits, and Mobile Home Park licenses.

**SAWSJPB Project Manager *Dan Coughlin***

Dan is responsible for the day to day administrative duties of SAWS. The City of Sheridan will continue to operate and maintain the system, bill the water users, and also continue to provide engineering and technical support as in the past.

**Administrative Assistant *Susan Berberick***

Susan helps the Public Works Department staff doing clerical work, filing, maintaining permit data files and taking minutes at meetings, as well as answering the phone and helping walk-in clients

**Code Enforcement Officers *Bob Shelley Jim Allender***

The County Code Enforcement Officers are responsible for ensuring private property and construction and development projects conform to zoning, and conditions of approval. They are also responsible for inspections, investigations, and resolution of zoning enforcement issues.

**Engineering Technician *Bill Pinkerton***

Bill is responsible for completing the computer-aided drafting and GPS surveying under the direction of the County Engineer. He also does Building and Septic inspections when needed.

**GIS Tech *Sandi Kerr***

Sandi is responsible for maintaining/updating GIS information, assigning addresses, preparing GIS maps and data base for the Public Works Department. She also maintains the Public Works website pages.

**Planning Assistant *Andrea Garrett***

Andrea is responsible for helping the Planner to administer the Sheridan County Subdivision Resolution, Rezoning permits, Quarry permits, Variance permits, Conditional Use permits, and Mobile Home Park licenses. In addition, she helps the Public Department staff doing clerical work, filing, maintaining permit data files and taking minutes at meetings, as well as answering the phone and helping walk-in clients

**Road and Bridge Program Manager *Pete Husman***

Pete is responsible for supervising the daily activities of the Road and Bridge Department including: road maintenance, minor bridge repair, snow removal, and culvert installation. In addition, he oversees the maintenance and repair of county vehicles; directs the operation of a variety of heavy, medium, and light equipment, including road graders, front end loaders, backhoes, dozers, and trucks.

**Special Projects Coordinator *George Rogers***

George is responsible for completing designs of county roads, culverts, county gravel and shale quarries, operating road management systems, cost accounting, administering contracts and inspections on contracted projects.
