

SPEED LIMITS ON COUNTY ROADS

The speed limit on Sheridan County roads is 45 mph, unless otherwise posted.

Adopted by Board of County Commissioners, September 5, 2000, Resolution 00-09-019.

COUNTY ROADS POSTED AT SPEEDS OTHER THAN 45 MPH

Absaraka Street (CR 1176) – 30 mph; curve posted at 20 mph

Badger Creek Road (CR 122) – 35 mph from Montana border to terminus.

Beatty Gulch Road (CR 1231) – 35 mph;

Beatty Spur Road (CR 108) – 35 mph;

Beaver Creek Road (CR 87) – 35 mph on south 2.6 miles of road.

Box Cross Road (CR 111) – 35 mph

Brinton Road (CR 103) – 35 mph

Coutant Creek Road (CR 114) – 35 mph;

Gulch Road (CR 121) – 30 mph

Higby Road, South (CR 123) – 20 mph

Higby Road, North (CR 1239) – 30 mph

Knode Road (CR 60) – 30 mph

Lower Prairie Dog Road (CR 1211) – 35 mph from intersection with State Highway 336 north to the Montana border;

Paradise Park Road (CR 72) – 35 mph

Pompey Creek Road (CR 129) – 35 mph

Upper Prairie Dog Road (CR 127) – 35 mph

Woodland Park Road (CR 66) – 45 mph, except incline on west end is 30 mph
