The following information must be submitted 45 days prior to meeting you would like to be on. Please schedule a meeting with staff to submit application. Required with application – Applicant must be the owner of the property:

- 1) Waiver from requirements if any
- 2) \$250.00 application fee in the form of cash or check made out to Sheridan County; Application must be owner
- 3) Stamped, pre-addressed business-sized envelope for each property owner within one half (1/2) mile of the boundary of the proposed quarry property
- 4) List of each property owner along with mailing address within one half (1/2) mile of the boundary of proposed quarry property; the County GIS Department can compile this list for a fee
- 5) Proof of ownership of property-warranty deed
- 6) Legal description of property
- 7) Letter of intent, explanation of proposal
- 8) A map indicating:
 - a) The boundaries of the quarry operation
 - b) The location of surrounding residences
 - c) The roads to be used in the quarry operation including haul roads

If minerals are federally owned, landowner is responsible for obtaining other required permits.
