

MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF SHERIDAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

The Board met at 9:00 a.m., Wednesday, August 01, 2012, in special session in the Commission Board Room, County Courthouse, Sheridan, Wyoming. Chairman Mike Nickel called the meeting to order and led everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance. Members present were Commissioners Terry Cram, Steve Maier, Mike Nickel, Tom Ringley and Bob Rolston.

MILL LEVY CERTIFICATION

Chairman Nickel called on Renee’ Obermueller, Administrative Director, and Paul Fall, County Assessor. Ms. Obermueller explained the process and answered questions. There were no members of the public present. Mr. Nickel stated in accordance with W.S. 39-13-102(g), the County Commissioners are charged to sit each year on or before the first Monday in August to certify mill levies for the collection of ad valorem taxes as required by applicable governmental entities. Taxes shall be distributed as specified in the Board’s Order prepared by the Administrative Director, in coordination with the County Assessor. Commissioner Rolston moved to authorize the Chairman to execute the Board’s Order, certifying the mill levies for Sheridan County as specified for 2012-13. Commissioner Maier seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.
