

MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF SHERIDAN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

The Board met at 8:45 a.m., Monday, August 4, 2014, in regular session, for the weekly staff meeting in the Commission Library, County Courthouse, Sheridan, Wyoming. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Cram. Commissioners Cram, Maier, Nickel, Ringley and Rolston were present.

AGENDA ADDITION

Commissioner Ringley moved to add a discussion with the City regarding the upcoming Congressional Tour. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

VOUCHER REVIEW

Commissioners reviewed monthly expenses for the county.

MILL LEVIES FY 2014-15

Chairman Cram announced the County Commissioners are charged to sit each year on or before the first Monday in August to certify mill levies for the collection of ad valorem taxes as required by applicable governmental entities. He also stated taxes shall be distributed as specified in the Board's Order prepared by the Administrative Director in coordination with the County Assessor. He then opened a public hearing and Paul Fall, County Assessor and Renee' Obermueller, Administrative Director, answered questions from the board. The public hearing was closed and Commissioner Rolston moved to authorize the Chairman to execute the Board's Order certifying the mill levies for Sheridan County as specified for 2014-15. The motion passed unanimously.

Eda Schunk Thompson, County Clerk; Renee' Obermueller, Administrative Director; and Rod Liesinger, Public Works Director, provided updates and answered questions from the board.


CITY DISCUSSION
