

DO YOU HAVE A REGISTERED CAMPER OR TRAVEL TRAILER?

e.g., 5th wheel camp trailer, livestock trailer with living quarters, or toy hauler with living quarters

As of **January 1, 2015**, there will be changes regarding the state fees on all new and current travel trailer plates registered in Wyoming.

Presently, the state fee on all travel trailers is \$15.00. At the beginning of the year, the state fee amount will vary depending on the *weight* of the travel trailer, just like all other types of trailers that are currently registered in Wyoming. Any new or current travel trailers registered or renewed before **December 31st, 2014**, will still have the \$15.00 state fee.

If you currently have a travel trailer licensed, after the 1st of the year the fees may change at the time of renewal, depending on the weight. Below is a guideline to help you find out if there will be an increase in state fees on your travel trailer.

Length (in feet)	Weight (in pounds)	State Fee
8-22	less than 3,500	\$15.00
23-26	3,501-4,500	\$20.00
27-28	4,501-5,600	\$30.00
29-30	5,601-6,000	\$40.00
31 and higher	6001 and higher	\$60.00

If you feel that your trailer doesn't fit into these guidelines, please feel free to have your trailer weighed at any local weighing station and present us with the weight slip.
