AGENDA

The agenda was approved as published.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

On behalf of the Board, Chairman Maier recognized Bev Gorzalka, University of Wyoming Cooperative Extension Office, for 30 years service as a County employee. Korkie Borzenski, Assessor's Office, was also recognized for ten years of service.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

There were no public comments.

SHERIDAN MEMORIAL HOSPITAL BOARD

The Board appointed Gene Davis of Sheridan to an unexpired term on the Sheridan Memorial Hospital board of trustees that runs to June 30, 2013.

NORTHERN WY MENTAL HEALTH CENTER

Upon the recommendation of the Center's board of directors, the Board appointed Mark Demple of Sheridan to fill a four-year, unexpired term to June 30, 2012.

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

Emergency Management Coordinator Dave Coleman advised that the presented Emergency Management Performance Grant supports half of the expenses for the local office, and does require a 50% match. He said the award period began on October 1,

2009 but was just received from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security. The award comes too late to accomplish some possible projects, but does provide funds for the office and equipment purchases. The Board accepted the award of \$29,042 and authorized the Chairman to execute the Grant Award Agreement, which runs to March 31, 2011.

PUBLIC HEALTH

Administrative Director Renee Obermueller advised that spring rains have brought to the County's attention a significant leak in the lower roof of the Public Health building. She said that nothing has been done to the building in the last 20 years except minor maintenance and the roof needs to be repaired prior to addressing internal damage. She said bids were received from Galloway Construction, Prill Brothers and Peak Construction. Commissioner Rolston noted that the Public Health building is part of the Courthouse campus and is county property. He said the repair has fallen on this Board to do. The Board awarded the bid to re-roof the lower roof of the Sheridan County Public Health building to Peak Construction, in the amount of \$16,465, for a term to September 17, 2010, and authorized the Chairman to execute the agreement.

FIRE RESTRICTIONS

Chairman Maier reported that upon the advice of the County Fire Warden and District Fire Chiefs, he signed Resolution 10-07-025 on July 26, 2010 so that the public could be made aware that partial fire restrictions would go into effect on July 29, 2010. The media was so advised and the resolution was set for affirmation by the full Board. He said the Board and staff have since taken the opportunity to rearrange the wording of the resolution to better clarify the restrictions. The Board approved the presented Resolution 10-07-025, setting out the parameters under which burning may be allowed in Sheridan County. The Resolution is available for viewing on the County web site.

RESOLUTION 10-07-025 PARTIAL FIRE RESTRICTIONS IN SHERIDAN COUNTY

WHEREAS, the danger from forest and range fires on lands within Sheridan County has an excessive amount of inflammable material available; and

WHEREAS, the County's rural fire protection districts believe that for the protection of life and property, restrictions should be instituted; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has unanimously recognized the necessity for fire prevention measures in Sheridan County; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Wyoming Statute 35-9-301, Boards of County Commissioners are duly authorized to close any or all state, county and private lands that lie outside incorporated areas, within their respective county, to open fires or other uses which constitute a serious threat to forest or range fire.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners, having set County fire restrictions in effect at **12:01 a.m., July 29, 2010**, does hereby declare that fires and open flames shall be allowed in improved areas only within the following parameters:

1. The area of said fire prevention measures shall include all state, county and private lands within Sheridan County except lands located within incorporated areas; municipal governments having the authority to declare fire restrictions locally. No campfires are allowed on State land. Private and public lands lying within the Bighorn National Forest boundary shall adhere to County fire restrictions when the Bighorn National Forest implements fire restrictions and when it lifts such restrictions.

2. Charcoal fires are permitted when contained within enclosed grills.
3. Trash or refuse fires are permitted, between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m., in a container provided with a spark arrester and located in the center of a cleared area, ten (10) feet in radius.
4. Campfires are permitted outside of the Bighorn National Forest boundary within established, commercial campgrounds or lodging facilities, and then only if they are centered with a twelve (12) foot cleared radius, free of any burnable vegetation or material. The fire ring or pit is to be constructed of non-flammable materials covered by metal plate and/or a heavy gauged metal screen with no larger than 1/4 inch openings in the screen. Campground and/or lodge owners are responsible for any escapes and damages.
5. Use of acetylene cutting torches or electric welders are permitted in cleared areas, ten (10) feet in radius.
6. Propane or open-fire branding activities are permitted in cleared areas, ten (10) feet in radius.
7. No open fires or open flame shall be permitted in unimproved areas.
8. Discharge of all fireworks is strictly prohibited, unless a Permit for Supervised Public Display of Fireworks is granted by the Board of County Commissioners.
9. The term "fireworks" shall not be construed as being synonymous with "fireworks" under W.S. 35-10-201. As used herein, "fireworks" means any pyrotechnic or explosive device regardless of the quantity of explosive contained therein.
10. There is no restriction on smoking.
11. There are no restrictions on cabin chimneys or flues. It is, however, advisable to install spark arresters or screens.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, pursuant to W.S. 35-9-304, any person violating this Resolution on state, county and private lands that fall under the jurisdiction of Sheridan County shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine not to exceed one-hundred dollars (\$100) or imprisonment in the County jail not to exceed thirty (30) days, or both such fine and imprisonment.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Resolution 10-07-025, dated August 3, 2010, supersedes all previous resolutions in this regard, and shall remain in full effect until such time as it may be amended or rescinded by Board action.
