

NOTICE OF INTENT TO AMEND RULES & REGULATIONS GOVERNING WASTEWATER SYSTEMS

The Sheridan County Board of County Commissioners hereby gives public notice of its intent to amend its Rules & Regulations Governing Wastewater Systems,

The purpose of the proposed amendments is to bring the County's rules into conformity with Chapter 25 of the Rules & Regulations of the Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality. These rules provide design and construction standards for small wastewater systems in order to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the environment and the public. The proposed rules meet the minimum substantive state statutory standards.

Copies of the proposed rules are available from the Sheridan County Department of Public Works. They may also be viewed on the County website.

A public hearing to receive oral comments on the proposed rules will be held on December 20, 2016 during the Board's regular meeting commencing at 9:00 am. Following the public hearing, the Board will consider adoption of the proposed amendments.
