In an effort to cut down on dust stirred up by vehicles along County roads, crews with the Sheridan County Road & Bridge department began the annual dust abatement program on Monday, April 20, 2015.

**** Due to weather constraints and product delivery there has been a delay in application. The same roads that were scheduled for the week of May 18th are now scheduled for the week of May 25th.**

Roads that are scheduled to have calcium-chloride milled into them during the week of May 25th include:

#	Name	Specific Area if applicable
255	Passaic Rd	Junction with Hwy 14-16 to Junction with CR 86
269	Lower Powder River Rd	Junction with Hwy 14-16 to the County line
38	Wild Horse Rd	Junction with Hwy 341 to County line

Please be alert for equipment working on the roads in these areas. If the magnesium-chloride splashes onto your vehicle, it is recommended that it be rinsed off before it dries. Use alternate route if possible.
