ABSENTEE VOTING

Absentee Voting is not new to Wyoming and remains an option for all Wyoming Voters. The voter can request and vote by Absentee Ballot for any reason.

Requesting an Absentee Ballot: A qualified elector may request an Absentee Ballot for the General Election any time by writing, by telephone, or in person. An absentee request form may be downloaded from our website at [Elections Office - Sheridan County Wyoming](#) Absentee Ballots will not be available on Election Day. For the General Election, the last day to request an Absentee Ballot will be Monday, November 7, 2022.

Deadline for Return of Absentee Ballot: Absentee Ballots must be returned to the Sheridan County Clerk’s Office or to the Sheridan County Election Office by 7:00 p.m. on November 8, 2022, to be counted for the General Election.

Absentee Polling Place for Sheridan County

For those voters who wish to vote early in person, an Absentee Polling Place will be located at the Sheridan County Courthouse, on the 2nd floor of the new addition, Room 210, from Friday, September 23, 2022, through Monday, November 7, 2022, from the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

NOTICE TO ABSENTEE VOTERS

Absentee Ballots cannot and will not be accepted at the Polling Locations on Election Day.

DO YOU NEED ASSISTANCE?

If a voter requires assistance at the polls to vote by reason of blindness, disability, or inability to read or write, the voter may be given assistance by a person of the voter’s choice.
