

**NOTICE OF INTENT TO AMEND RULES & REGULATIONS
GOVERNING THE LICENSING OF LIQUOR SALES**

The Sheridan County Board of County Commissioners hereby gives public notice of its intent to amend its Rules & Regulations Governing the Licensing of Liquor Sales.

The purpose of the proposed amendment is to add a requirement for employees of all liquor licensees to complete "Training for Intervention Procedures" (TIPS). The proposed rules meet the minimum substantive state statutory standards.
