

Sheridan County Backup Generator Upgrades and Additions

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed Bids for the **Sheridan County Backup Generator Upgrades and Additions** will be received by the Sheridan County, the OWNER, at the 224 S Main Street, Suite B-1, Sheridan, WY 82801, attention: Renee Obermueller, Administrative Director, until 3:00 p.m. prevailing local time, on August 31, 2022. The bid opening will be held in the Commission Board Room, 2nd floor of the new addition to the Courthouse, at which time the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The Work includes and consists of furnishing all labor, operations, materials, accessories, incidentals, services and equipment indicated, specified, mentioned, scheduled or implied per the Bid Documents for work on the specific aforementioned project. The specific Work includes: upgrade of the existing Courthouse generator system and adding standby backup power to the Juvenile Justice, Attorney's Office and Public Health buildings, including all other related items of work as shown on the Bid Documents; and/or work not specifically mentioned which are necessary in order to provide a complete project shall be included in the Bid and shall conform to all Local, State, and Federal requirements in accordance with the requirements, terms, specifications, conditions, and provisions hereinafter contained. The work varies by building, with the earliest construction start date to begin October 17, 2022 and the latest Substantial Completion date as July 21, 2023, as indicated in the Bid Documents.

A MANDATORY PREBID MEETING will begin at the Sheridan County Courthouse, 224 S Main Street, Sheridan, Wyoming, in the Commission Board Room, 2nd floor of the new addition to the Courthouse on August 24, 2022 at 10:00 am, prevailing local time. The Prebid Meeting is MANDATORY for all Prime Electrical Bidders, and after a briefing for the overall project in the Commission Board Room, the Meeting will proceed with a tour to all of the project locations.

In determining the lowest responsive bid, the Owner will consider all acceptable bids on a basis consistent with the Bid package. The Owner will also consider whether the bidder is a responsible bidder.

All Bids must be signed and accompanied by evidence of authority to sign. Bids must be accompanied by Bid Security in the form of a bid bond (penal sum form), certified check, or cashiers check in the amount of 5% of the bid proposal. The bid security shall be drawn upon a surety company with a rating of A or better according to the Best publication and licensed in the State of Wyoming. Said bid security shall be forfeited to Sheridan County as liquidated damages should the successful bidder fail to enter into contract in accordance with their proposal as specified in the Instruction to Bidders. The Owner reserves the right to waive any informality or to reject any or all Bids.

No Bidder may withdraw his Bid within forty-five (45) days after the date of the opening thereof.
